- Develop format for FLISA New Attendees Meeting at NAFIS Conference
- Create an outline about FLISA that could be used to explain Impact Aid and FLISA to a local school board. (This could accompany the new FLISA video)
- Contact 7002 Districts to share info about the FLISA Website and the new FLISA video
- E.Contact Congressional Offices to share info about the FLISA Webstie and the new FLISA video
- Create short (30-45 second) version of the new FLISA website

Involvement Committee Work Session

Overall purpose of the Involvement Committee:

- Get districts involved that aren't involved at all, specifically at the State level through state targeted meetings.
- Provide strategies and resources to Districts to enhance communications with legislators.
- Maintain a comprehensive up-to-date database of all 7002 District contacts.
- Ensure that a FLISA representative is visiting all key legislators as identified by NAFIS.

Work Completed at Summer Meeting:

- Continued work on completing the 7002 District Funding contact spreadsheet and assigning state specific meeting coordinators.
- Review and finalized information packets of information for use at state specific meetings, new member orientation, legislative office visits, community education, etc. Created electronic file of documents on the FLISA website.
- Began work on drafting an agenda or template for meeting coordinators to follow.
- Identified all congressional offices that are being visited and communicated to on a regular basis and those that are not currently seen that should be (coordinated effort with NAFIS office). Assigned

FLISA members to meet and communicate with legislators at the Fall conference.

Technology Committee Work Session

After deliberations and discussions the Technology Committee recommends:

- We would like to create a 60 second to 90 second video from our newly produced video. We have multiple places where it could be used.
- We suggest we remind everyone to check our website for minutes (print?) before every meeting. Copies will not be provided.
- We want to create a space on our website for "Advocacy Resources" such as leave behinds, thank you notes, etc.
- We will look into the possibilities of adding an Alert Banner and RSS Feed.
- It was suggested we expand our language about getting involved.
- We will explore whether our website is fully ADA compliant.
- We will explore adding a note on the front page for "Tell Us What You Think" about our website on a Google Form.
- We will find out if it is possible to use Twitter or Facebook to send pictures to our website. We will explore security concerns.
